SCAVENGER HUNT

In groups of three or four students decrypt A. Clue One. Clue One is a clue to where the next cipher (B. Clue Two) is found. Once Clue One has been decrypted, write down where you believe the next cipher can be found. Once all of the groups have finished deciphering the clue and written down where they each think the next cipher is, the teacher will read off the answers and then reveal the location of the second cipher and so on until all three clues are solved.
